

LINE VARIATION

Exploring different line thicknesses can also give a drawing “weight” and “depth”. This will be our final project. Trust your intuition and vary the thickness of your line. Before you start fill up a page full of extremely varied squiggly lines. Understand your drawing tool and the type of line it makes, how it responds to different pressures. Then, once you feel comfortable you are going to move onto drawing your final project.

Explore the various techniques of drawing. Include all you have learned in this class - example - cross hatching, stippling, shading and more. Emphasis is placed on the exploration of the medium through drawing.
